

Grading Policy Information

- Paperless Report Cards
 - During the 2008-2009 school year UCFSD will begin to implement a paperless report card system. Those families wishing to participate during the 2008-2009 school year may opt to receive a paperless report card only. Parents may make this request on SAM under the notifications tab of the parent portal.
 - During the 2009-2010 school year parents will receive an electronic report card. Parents wishing to continue to receive a paper report card may request this on SAM under the notifications tab of the parent portal.
 - All information that is found on the paper report card is included on the electronic report card.
- Report Card Grades
 - Report card grades are truncated to two decimal places
 - Final grades on report cards include both percentage and letter grades
 - The UCFSD grade scale is as follows:
 - A+ = 97 to 100
 - A = 93 to 96
 - A- = 90 to 92
 - B+ = 87 to 89
 - B = 83 to 86
 - B- = 80 to 82
 - C+ = 77 to 79
 - C = 73 to 76
 - C- = 70 to 72
 - D+ = 67 to 69
 - D = 63 to 66
 - D- = 60 to 62
 - F = Below 60
- Final Grades
 - Marking period grades are truncated to two decimal places
 - Final grades are rounded ($\geq .5$ rounds to the next whole number)
- GPA Calculations
 - Current student GPA's can be found on SAM
 - GPA calculations take place at the end of each school year based on final grades
 - Questions regarding GPA's should be directed to your school counselor
- Transcripts
 - Unofficial transcripts for all high school students are available on SAM from August 15 until November 1.
 - Only final grades, not percentages, will be posted on transcripts.
 - If you are concerned about transcript accuracy, please contact your counselor immediately.
