Dear Parent(s) and/or Guardian(s):

This letter is to inform you that the Reading & Mathematics portions of the Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSA) will be administered to 11th grade students this March. The testing dates at Unionville High School will be March 20, 21, & 22.

While your 9th, 10th, or 12th grade student will not be participating in this assessment, his/her schedule on these days will be impacted. The information that follows will provide you with the schedule on these days and should answer many of your questions.

PSSA Reading & Mathematics Schedule March 20, 21, & 22

- **Tuesday, March 20**
 - 9th, 10th, & 12th report to school at the regular time
 - 9th & 12th will be dismissed at 10:30 a.m.
 - **10th graders choosing to take the PLAN* test will remain until 2:18 p.m.**
 - 10th graders NOT taking the PLAN test will be dismissed at 10:30 a.m.
- **Wednesday, March 21**
 - 9th, 10th, & 12th report to school at the regular time
 - 9th, 10th, & 12th will be dismissed at 10:30 a.m.
- **Thursday, March 22**
 - 9th, 10th, & 12th report to school at the regular time
 - 9th, 10th, & 12th will be dismissed at 10:30 a.m.

*As mentioned above, on Tuesday, March 20th, we will be offering the PLAN test to tenth graders. This is the practice version of the ACT, one of the two tests that colleges will accept in the college application process. By taking the PLAN, students can compare their performance on the PLAN to their performance on the PSAT and decide which test will be more advantageous to them in applying to colleges.

District transportation will be provided for 9th, 10th, & 12th grade students at the 10:30 am dismissal time.


Lunch will be available for purchase through our cafeteria for those 10th grade students remaining for the afternoon program on March 20th. Furthermore, should you be unable to have your 9th or 10th grade student(s) come home at 10:30 a.m. on any of these days, please call the main office at 610-347-1600, and we will place your student in a supervised study hall for the remainder of the afternoon.

TCHS Students:

9th, 10th, & 12th grade TCHS students will participate in their programs after spending their morning at UHS. On Wednesday, March 21st, during the three periods where TCHS students do not have scheduled classes, they will report to a supervised study hall until the 10:30 a.m. dismissal if they arrive on the bus in the morning. However, if students are able to arrange for transportation, or would like to ride the bus in with the juniors on the three hour delay schedule, they may report to school by 11 a.m. to catch the bus to TCHS. The cafeteria will be open for vo-tech students until 11 a.m. to ensure that TCHS students are able to purchase and eat lunch prior to leaving for their technical program. Regular bus transportation will be provided both to and from TCHS.
