

Program Requirements

Doctor/RN signature on all current vaccination records
 COVID-19

- ✓ Flu (once available for school year)
- Pertussis (within last 6 years)
- Proof of Varicella (Chicken Pox)
 immunization or date of disease
- Signed disclosure for criminal record (form provided by Instructor in the Fall)
- \checkmark Copies of current health insurance
- ✓ QuantiFERON (Blood work for TB)
- Urine drug screening (must pass)
- Child Abuse Clearance Record
- ✓ Driver's License
- \checkmark 3 free periods in senior schedule
