## UNIONVILLE HIGH SCHOOL PARKING REGULATIONS

- 1. Students are expected to operate vehicles in a safe and responsible manner. All vehicles must have a valid permit visibly displayed on the rearview mirror at all times.
- 2. All vehicles need to be registered with the main office. Students can add additional vehicles should they need to do so. Please contact the main office with any questions pertaining to new vehicles.
- 3. Students who fail to display a valid permit will be warned once. Subsequent violations may result in Level 2 Code of Conduct consequences.
- 4. Students may not share permits. The student with the permit must be the driver of the registered vehicle. This is a Level 2 Code of Conduct violation.
- 5. Please note that failure to follow driving/ parking permit instructions is a Level 2 Code of Conduct violation. Repeat parking offenses can be elevated to Level 3. Consequences for parking violations can include a temporary or permanent loss of driving/parking privileges.
- 6. Parking privileges can be suspended for non-vehicle related offenses if administration determines loss of privileges is an appropriate consequence for a Code of Conduct violation (Policy 218).
- 7. Student vehicles parked on school property are subject to search by school officials.
- 8. A student's driving privileges **will be revoked** for the remainder of the semester if a student:
  - exceeds five unexcused latenesses to school;
  - gives or sells his/her parking permit to another student;
  - <u>cuts school/truancy;</u>
  - <u>leaves the school building or grounds without permission;</u>
  - drives recklessly on school property
  - receives a level 3 or level 4 disciplinary consequence.
